Parents did you know that research says that most children’s reading ‘dips’ in the 6 week holidays as they practise this vital skill far less than in term time? This can mean they come back into new year groups with a need to catch up on their reading skills to get them to where they were before the summer – at a time when they are adjusting to new classes/learning etc. A university research project on the Libraries Summer Reading Challenge showed that for even keen readers – doing the Reading Challenge, they read far more books over the holidays than other keen readers who did not do the Reading Challenge.
