You could even personify the parts of the digestive system and create an exciting adventure story.</p>

You can use the activity sheet or be more creative in the materials you use. There are some good ideas online. Ask me for the activity sheet if completing this task.</p>	<p>Throughout our life we all have role models we look up to. They may be in our families, people we meet throughout life or celebrities. Who do you look up to and why? How could you share and display this information?</p>	<p>We all have amazing qualities and talents. When we think about our futures we may want to develop these skills. Think about a hobby or talent you have. Prepare a short talk about it e.g. how you first became involved, and what skills you have that make you successful etc.</p>
