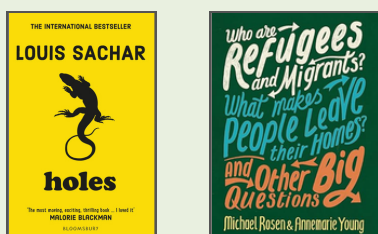

Top Tips for Home Reading Inspiration

Make it Cosy: Create a dedicated, comfortable reading spot with pillows and blankets.

Be a Role Model: Let your child see you reading for pleasure - whether it's a book, newspaper, or magazine.

Follow Their Interests: Reading doesn't just mean novels; allow children to choose comics, graphic novels, non-fiction books, or even recipes and instructions.

Bring Stories to Life: Use funny voices, act out scenes, and use props to make characters engaging.

Bring Reading into Everyday Life: Read signs, posters, and place names or find food labels at the supermarket.

Use the Library: Visit your local library to explore new genres, join reading challenges, or attend storytimes.

Encourage "Book Talk": Discuss the stories by asking questions like "What do you think will happen next?" or "Why did that character do that?"
