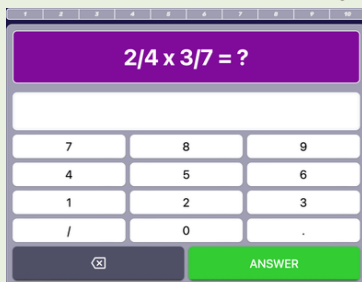

We have recently subscribed to Arithmagicians which is an engaging online game that helps children quickly recall key maths fact ranging over a wide range of topics.

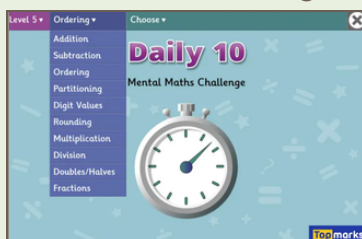
