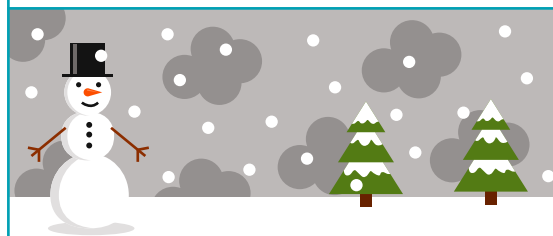

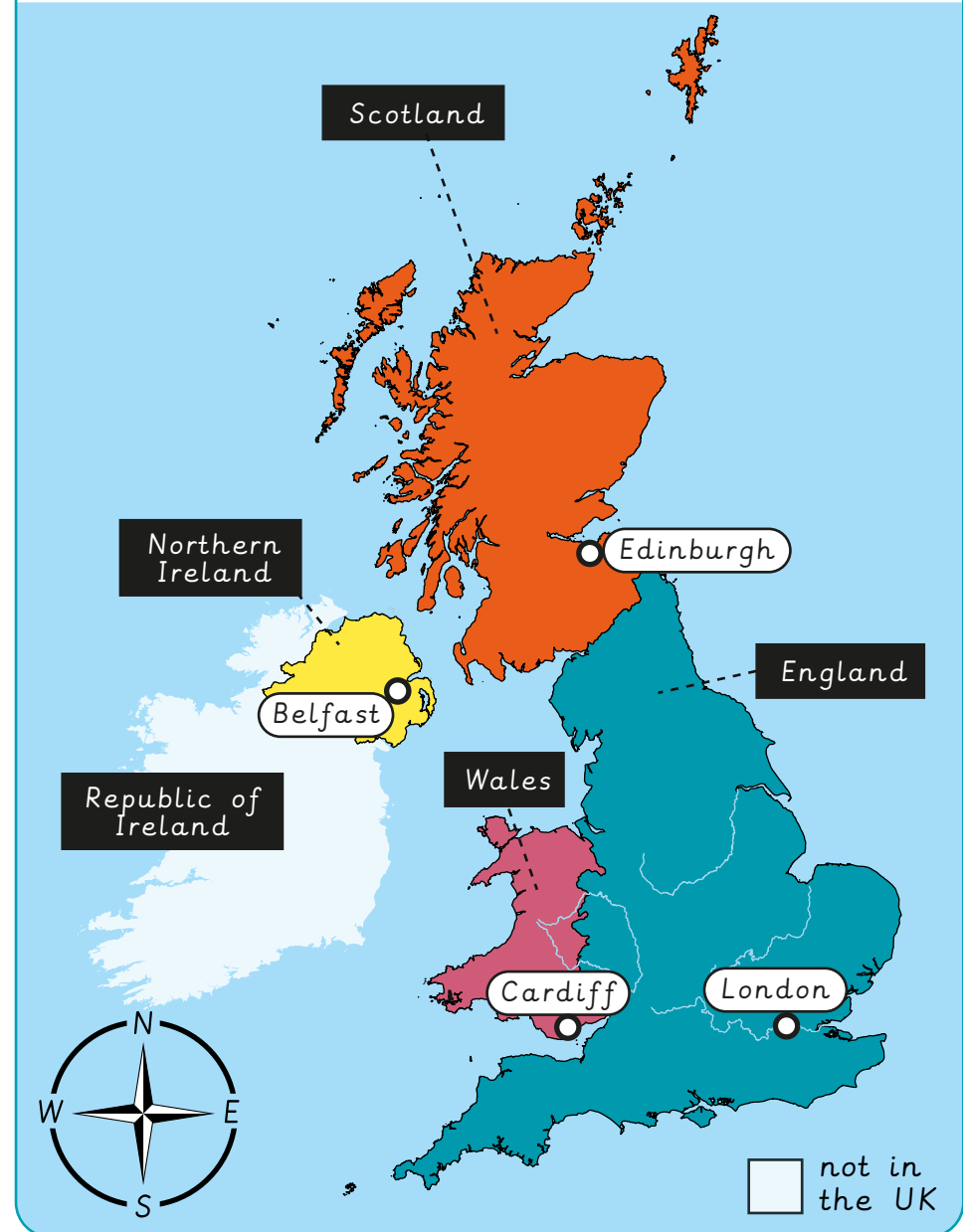

Tanzania

Where is it?

- Tanzania is in Africa.
- It has a coastline on the Indian Ocean.
- It borders Burundi, Congo (Democratic Republic), Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Rwanda, Uganda and Zambia.
- The capital city is Dodoma.



What sights might you see?

- Kilimanjaro is the highest mountain in Africa.
- Part of Lake Victoria is in Tanzania. It is the second-largest freshwater lake in the world.
- The Rufiji is the country's largest river.

What is the wildlife like?
